COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS 2021-22 INDOOR PERCUSSION SEASON

This document will provide you with our COVID safety protocols for this year's Indoor Percussion season, as well as our process for handling a situation where a student feels ill or exhibits COVID-like symptoms at one of our rehearsals or competitions. It is our intention to follow federal, state and Beaverton School District guidelines to ensure that all students, staff and volunteers remain safe at all times.

Masks and Social Distancing

Governor Kate Brown has instructed the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to require masks indoors in all K-12 schools for staff, students, visitors and volunteers, regardless of whether they're vaccinated or not. As part of a federal mandate, passengers and drivers must wear a mask on school buses. Drivers do not need to wear masks if they are the only person on the bus. Students will be required to wear a mask while indoors.

COVID Vaccinations

BSD is not requiring students to get the COVID-19 vaccine at this time. Per Governor Kate Brown's recent order, BSD will now require all staff members and volunteers be fully vaccinated by October 18th or six weeks after the FDA approves a vaccination, whichever is later; exemptions may be made for eligible medical or religious reasons.

Meal Service

At competitions, students will need to be responsible for bringing lunch or purchasing food at concession stands. If you need assistance with providing your student with a meal, please let us know so we can help.

Protocols If a Student Feels Ill or Exhibits COVID-like Symptoms

If a student feels ill or is exhibiting COVID-like symptoms at a competition, they must immediately inform a staff member or parent volunteer. We will have a medical-grade, touchless forehead thermometer to assess if the student has a fever and isolate the student in a safe location if needed. The student's designated emergency contact(s) will be notified immediately and the student must be picked up prior to the ensemble departing the competition site to return to school, as the student will not be able to ride home on the bus with the other students if they are feeling ill. If a student tests positive for COVID, we will follow the BSD guidelines for quarantine, contact tracing, etc.
